



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HOW THE PROGRAM WORKS

Participants attend an opening retreat and e two-day sessions over a nine-month period.

OPENING RETREAT

The program begins with an overnight retreat at Heartwood Resort & Conference Center in Trego, WI on July 24-25, 2024 where attendees participate in a number of team-building activities. Attendance at the retreat is mandatory.

The eight one-day sessions are held once a month on Wednesdays from 7:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. throughout the school year. No session is held in January. Each session offers a hands-on ience and a unique opportunity to interact with community leaders and discuss community issues. The class will participate in activities and discussions focused on leadership principles. In addition, students will be exposed to different

A Note on Diplomas.

Occasionally when senior students pick up their diploma in June, a student notices their legal name is spelled incorrectly. The spelling of the names is taken directly from the student's record in Skyward. Please check your student's name in Skyward to confirm that the spelling is correct. Also, confirm that it is their legal name. If either of these are incorrect, please stop by the North High School Registrar's office with a copy of your birth certificate so your permanent records can be updated. Diplomas will be ordered March 18, 2024. After this date, any corrections made will be the student's responsibility, including contacting Jostens directly and paying for any cost incurred. 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


DID YOU KNOW?

Research shows that students that miss more than 10 days a year are 20% less likely to graduate on time. By coming to school each day they aren't sick, your student is staying on track for graduation.

Husky Families -

In our ongoing efforts to consistently provide accurate attendance data, we have created a new absence code in Skyward. This code will show up as "V" when a student reports to class significantly late (5+ minutes). Below is a description of absent types, we hope you find this information helpful in monitoring your student's attendance.



Beginning at 7:35am, all students entering the building must check in at the front office. The kiosk automatically reports a student unexcused absence and prints out a time stamped ticket. Students give this ticket to their teacher and attendance will be adjusted accordingly. An excused absence or tardy will be cleared by the attendance office following family request.
