Trytten Scholarship UW Stevens Point

This scholarship is awarded to an incoming freshman who intends to major in Chemistry at the University of Wisconsin Stevens Point. Criteria for selection is a declared major of chemistry at UWSP at the time of application, earned at least a 3.50 GPA in high school, and have demonstrated capacity and potential for excellence in the field of chemistry.

Wisconsin Professional Police Association Scholarship

Any student enrolling in a college or vocational/technical school in a course of study leading to a two-year or four-year degree in police science, criminal justice, or a law enforcement-related field (which does not include law school) is eligible. Financial need is not criteria for selection in this scholarship.

***Don Moss Memorial Scholarship**

One senior from North who is attending a post-secondary institution in the fall will receive this \$500 scholarship. Students must have a minimum GPA of a 3.0, participated in at least one athletic program, demonstrate good sportsmanship qualities and potential in school and in the community.

J. Murphy STEM Scholarship

All North and Memorial High School seniors who intend to pursue post-secondary education and study under a STEM program major (science, technology, engineering, math) and will be pursuing a career in a STEM field will be considered for this scholarship. Selection is based on an intent to attend a post-secondary education program with a STEM field major and plans to pursue a career in a STEM field. Students must have a GPA of a B average or higher (3.0) and must demonstrate financial need (detailed in your FAFSA SAR). Students are required to provide a recommendation letter from a teacher. Preference is given to students planning to attend a public university and preference is also given to female applicants. Scholarship amount is \$10,000 renewable annually for four years of post-secondary education.

The Distinguished Raven FAC Memorial Scholarship

Descendants or legal wards of any Lao or Hmong individual who served in the Royal Laotian Military or Hmong forces in defense of the Kingdom of Laos between 1960 and 1975 are eligible to compete for this scholarship. No individual may be selected for two consecutive years, nor may he/she receive more than two scholarships. Applicants must be a high school senior or graduated and must be enrolled or actively seeking to enroll full time in the coming academic year in an undergraduate program of studies leading to a Bachelor or Associate Degree at an accredited college, junior college, or university in the United States. Technical school attendees will also be considered.

Applicants must be accepted as a full-time or part-time student within post-secondary programming, college or course(s) at an educational institution located in Eau Claire County. Applicants must be identified in ECASD records as having experienced homelessness. Applicants must submit a completed scholarship application and supporting documents.
