HELPFUL INFORMATION

<u>REMINDER!</u> Putnam implements a staggered start for kindergarten students, which provides those children more one-on-one time and attention to learn school routines and expectations. Kindergarten children will come either **Tuesday**, **September 5 or Wednesday**, **September 6.** A letter will be sent home in June to all kindergarten families regarding the staggered start. The first day with the **FULL** kindergarten group will be **Thursday**, **September 7.**

Below is information you may find helpful as the school year begins.

Bussing

Student Transit provides all the bussing for the Eau Claire Area School District. If you have questions regarding bus transportation, please contact Student Transit at 715-839-5116. Bussing for students begins on Tuesday, September 5 and the buses will run at their usual times. Please be aware that the routes often take a bit longer at the beginning of the school year, so your child(ren) could be arriving home a bit later than expected on the first days of school.

• Food and Nutrition Program

 You may pay as far in advance as you like, but please pay at least two weeks in advance. Check out the district's website at www.ecasd.us for the latest breakfast, lunch and milk prices. You can add money to your child's account through www.myschoolbucks.com.

Medication

o If your child requires medication to be administered by school staff, please be sure to complete a new form which is located in the office. **NO** prescription or over-the-counter medication shall be given to a student by **any** employee of the District unless written instructions for administering medication, signed by the prescribing physician/licensed prescriber, along with written authorization from the parent(s)/guardian(s), authorizing school personnel to give medication in the dosage prescribed by the physician/licensed prescriber, have been delivered along with the drug to designated school personnel. In order for school personnel to administer the medication, parent(s) /guardian(s) must complete and submit the approved child/student medication management forms.

Custodial Information for Children of Separated/Divorced Parents

 If there are any custodial agreements or family changes, please stop by the office to complete a form. We hope you will also update that information throughout the year as needed.
