
>>> MONTESSORI FEST & ART SHOW

THE MONTESSORI WAY >>> WHAT DOES IT MEAN?

Many of you have probably heard a few Montessori terms being used by teachers and may be wondering what they mean.



Spiral Curriculum: The spiral curriculum exposes students to many interrelated topics repeatedly over time because one lesson leads to many others. Children continue to build sequentially on previously learned skills by exploring the same materials at different levels. With each repetition, children build the knowledge they already have about a topic, delving deeper into the details, seeing the connections more clearly, and ultimately developing a deep understanding of our complex world. Starting with the broad picture and increasing detail while narrowing focus, the child moves from concrete experiences toward abstract understanding.
