- Accelerated Learning
 - a. Heather Grant is the elementary level director of Gifted and Talented
 - i. New split into 2 roles (Elementary and MS/HS)
 - b. Discussed the ways students are identified as potential G/T
 - i. Process between identification and execution
 - ii. 5th and 6th grade math is offered at middle schools
 - c. Parent concerns
 - i. The disconnect between G/T math at elementary and middle
 - 1. Not a lot of info sharing, confusion about school roles at both ends
 - 2. Lack of community/connection for parents in the program
 - 3. Unclear expectations about the content covered in 5th grade
 - ii. No accelerated ELA
 - iii. Odyssey of the Mind
 - 1. Parents miss the opportunity
 - a. Understanding that out of 10 WI teams, 3 were from EC
 - 2. After school groups are allowed with a faculty advisor
- II. FAC Purpose Discussion
 - a. Frustration that the group is not being utilized as it was pre-covid
 - i. Used to be a forum to learn/help before content went to the School Board
 - ii. Given the opportunity to weigh in on decisions before they were made
 - 1. Currently we are given presentations with little opportunity to impact
 - 2. School Board is now a coherent governance model
 - a. FAC is no longer required as part of that model
 - iii. Key Communicators Group
 - 1. Purpose stated mirrors posted FAC description
 - 2. Community members and possible school representatives





- 3. Members are chosen/invited where FAC is volunteer
 - a. Lots of big feelings around this
- iv. Looking for guidance and information
- III. I Love You Guys (w/ Brian Marks)
 - a. Overview of Rapid Response protocol improvements/progress
 - b. Discussed a potential reunification drill in the spring with parents
