Math	Subtraction bowling: Set up 10 Plastic Cups and roll a small ball (make one from aluminum foil if you don't have one). Then see how many cups fell down and record your subtraction equation. Ex. $10-3=7$	Find all the Partners of 8. Put 8 small objects in a row. Use a pencil as a break-apart stick to break up the objects into two groups. Move the pencil to various spots to find all the partners of 8. Record the partners.	Can you find 100 things in your backyard? Pinecones, rocks, sticks, etc.. Group them by 10 and count by 1s and 10s to 100.	Using objects or by drawing a picture solve the following story problem: Jess found 5 butterflies and 3 grasshoppers.
