Description of Northstar Middle School Volunteer Activities

Chaperoning Polar Parties

Polar Parties are held 4 times per year and allow students to swim, play games, dance, eat, and socialize with their friends in a supervised setting. Parents are needed to chaperone these events from 2:40-4:15 pm. The dates for this year are October 28, December 9, February 10, and April 28.

Provide Food for Hospitality

Several times a year the PTSA provides food for special events. This is easy for you to do and does not require you to be at school. Food items are dropped off at school at a designated area or sent to school with your child. Two specific dates are when we host dinner for staff on Family Teacher Conference days of **October 13** and **February 16**. Other opportunities occur during the school year.

PTSA Concessions for February 23 Forensics Meet

We will be hosting a concession stand for the **February 23, 2023** Forensics Meet. We will need extra volunteers to work from either **3:15-5:30 PM** or **5:30-7:00 PM**, and volunteers to provide baked goods.

Staff & Bus Driver Appreciation Week

The Staff and Bus Driver Appreciation Committee needs assistance in serving and providing desserts for the luncheon and other supplies during Staff Appreciation Week, the **first full week in May**.

Media Center

Volunteers will assist with basic library jobs such as shelving books, filing, checking in new materials, and other miscellaneous jobs. Shifts can be worked around your schedule. Other assistance is needed occasionally.

Mile Run

Under the direction of Northstar P.E. teachers, parent volunteers help setup, cut up fruit, serve fruit, Gatorade, water, and put things away. The fall mile run is **October 18 & 19**, and the spring mile run is **May 3 & 4**. There is a morning shift from **7:15-11:05** and an afternoon shift from **11:05-2:50**.

Book Fair

The Book Fair is held during Family/Teacher Conferences. Morning, afternoon, and evening shifts are available in the fall on **October 13** and in the winter on **February 16**. All volunteers receive a free \$5.00 coupon towards any purchase at the Book Fair.
