Don't forget tomorrow is pick-up day for student materials at Putnam. Kindergarten's pick up time is: 7:30-9:30am, 11am-1pm, and 4-6pm. Families will be able to drive up to the pickup/drop-off lane of the parking lot, and they should stay in their cars. We will have two staff outside with radios taking names from families, and staff inside will bring out the bags. We are limited on the number of staff we are allowed to have on school grounds at one time, so we appreciate your patience. We have also found that a number of items from classrooms and lockers are unable to be identified on who they belong to. We have a "lost and found" box for each classroom for these items, so we will do our best to identify items for you.

The district will be gathering feedback from families in the next coming weeks through phone calls following a district created protocol. Erin Anderson will be assisting Putnam Heights and organizing the project. Putnam families that are contacted would be contacted by Putnam staff. The conversations will include talking through how things are going with At Home Learning, summer school programming, technology needs and the social emotional well-being of our students. The information gathered will help the district determine present and future needs as groundwork is laid for next fall.
