
Our 3rd quarter PBIS Celebration was a March Madness layup competetion. It was fun to have the entire school together in the gym.

Our 8th grade students will be going on an end of the year celebratory trip to Valley Fair the last day of school, Wednesday,

The trip includes a round trip coach bus ride, admission to Valley Fair and Soak City, pizza, and snacks for the way home. The total cost per student is estimated to be around \$50. Because of the price, we are offering students the opportunity to Fundraise for a lower total cost by selling Kwik Trip gift cards.

For every \$100 dollars sold in gift cards, \$5 will go directly to <u>your</u> student's trip fee.
